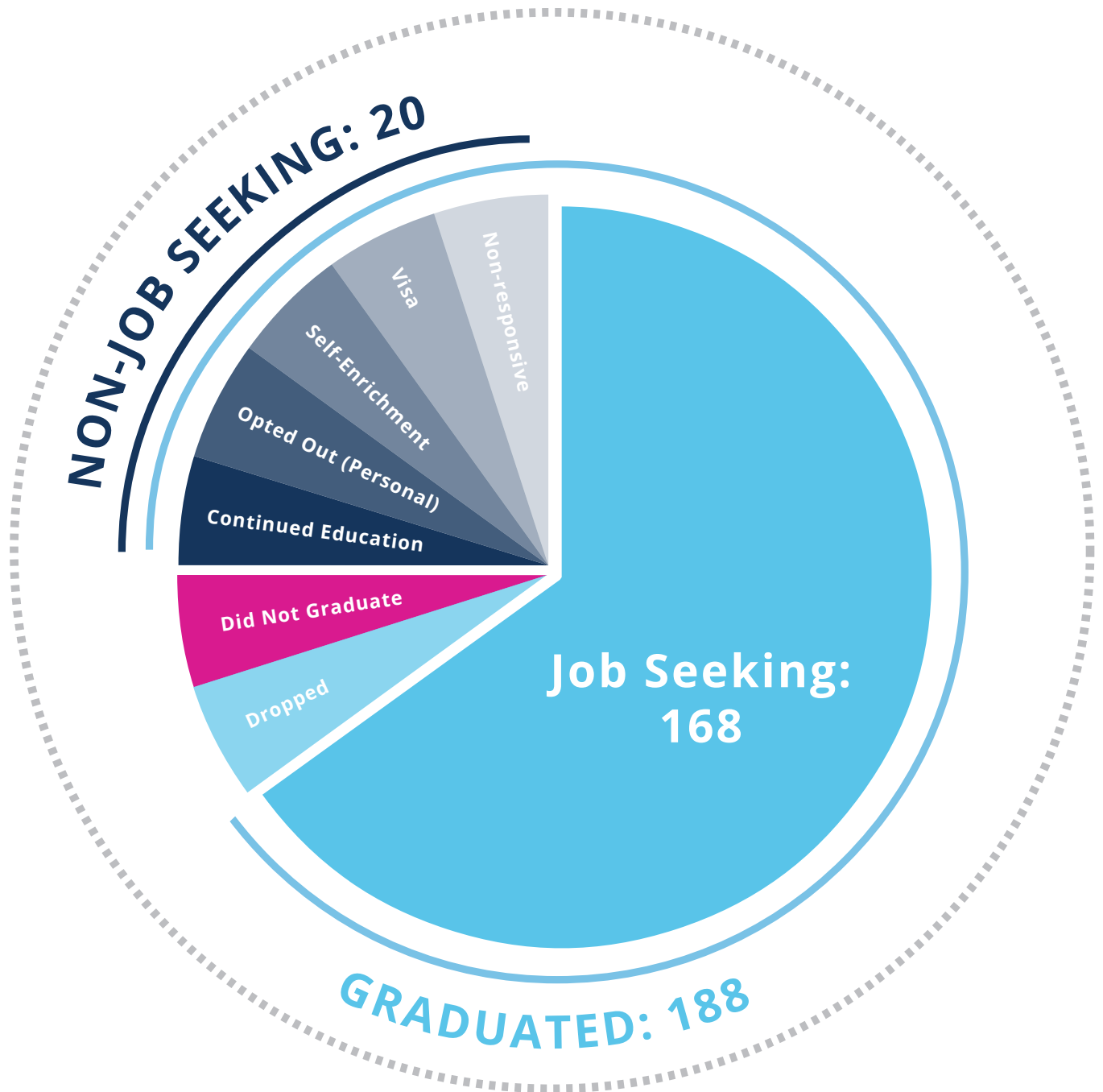
DEFINITIONS

Enrolled	Student who made a tuition payment and is present for the first week of class.
Dropped	Student who stopped attending Wyncode after the first week of class.
Non-Graduated	Student who failed to complete the requirements of the Wyncode program, as per the Wyncode Catalog.
Graduated	Student who completed the nine weeks of the bootcamp according to the requirements of the Wyncode Catalog.
Job Seeking	Graduate who was actively looking for work 90 days after graduation
Non-Job Seeking	Graduate who immediately returned to a previous employer, returned to school, did not have a US visa, opted out for personal reasons, only pursued Wyncode for self-enrichment or was non-responsive.
Placed	Graduate who found one of the following types of employment. Full-Time: role was at least 30 hours a week. Part-Time: role was less than 30 hours a week.
Internship/ Apprenticeship	Graduates placed within a temporary role and/or focused on a learning role. These positions may be paid or unpaid; unpaid roles were not included in average salary.
Entrepreneur	Graduate started their own company after Wyncode. Why does Wyncode consider entrepreneurs as placed? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Wyncode's program teaches coding and business skills. It is extremely supportive of entrepreneurs and encourages entrepreneurial ventures. ▶ Miami consistently ranks as one of the top cities in the US for entrepreneurship, as per the Kauffman Index, making it a hotbed of entrepreneurial activity ▶ Wyncoders who became entrepreneurs after the program used the skills they acquired at Wyncode to pursue their own companies instead of full-time employment.
Contractor/Freelancer	Graduates took one or more paid projects that fulfilled more than a forty hour work week.
Technical Roles	Graduates who work in a technical role, defined as working as a part of, or directly with, an engineering team.
Placement Dates	If a graduate was hired full time but we were unable to confirm their placement date, we considered them placed after 120 days to provide the most conservative estimate.
Average Salary	Base salary received in the first role accepted immediately following graduation from Wyncode. How did we calculate the "average salary" of students: First, we took all the data that was submitted by Wyncode graduates or their employers. This did not include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Graduates who were in unpaid roles. ▶ Graduates who did not report salary. Wyncode graduates submitted salary information as a range (\$40k-\$45k, \$45-\$50k, etc). Second, we calculated the average by taking the median of the ranged salary reported. So, if a graduate reported a salary in the range of \$40k-\$45k, the number recorded in determining the average would be \$42,500.



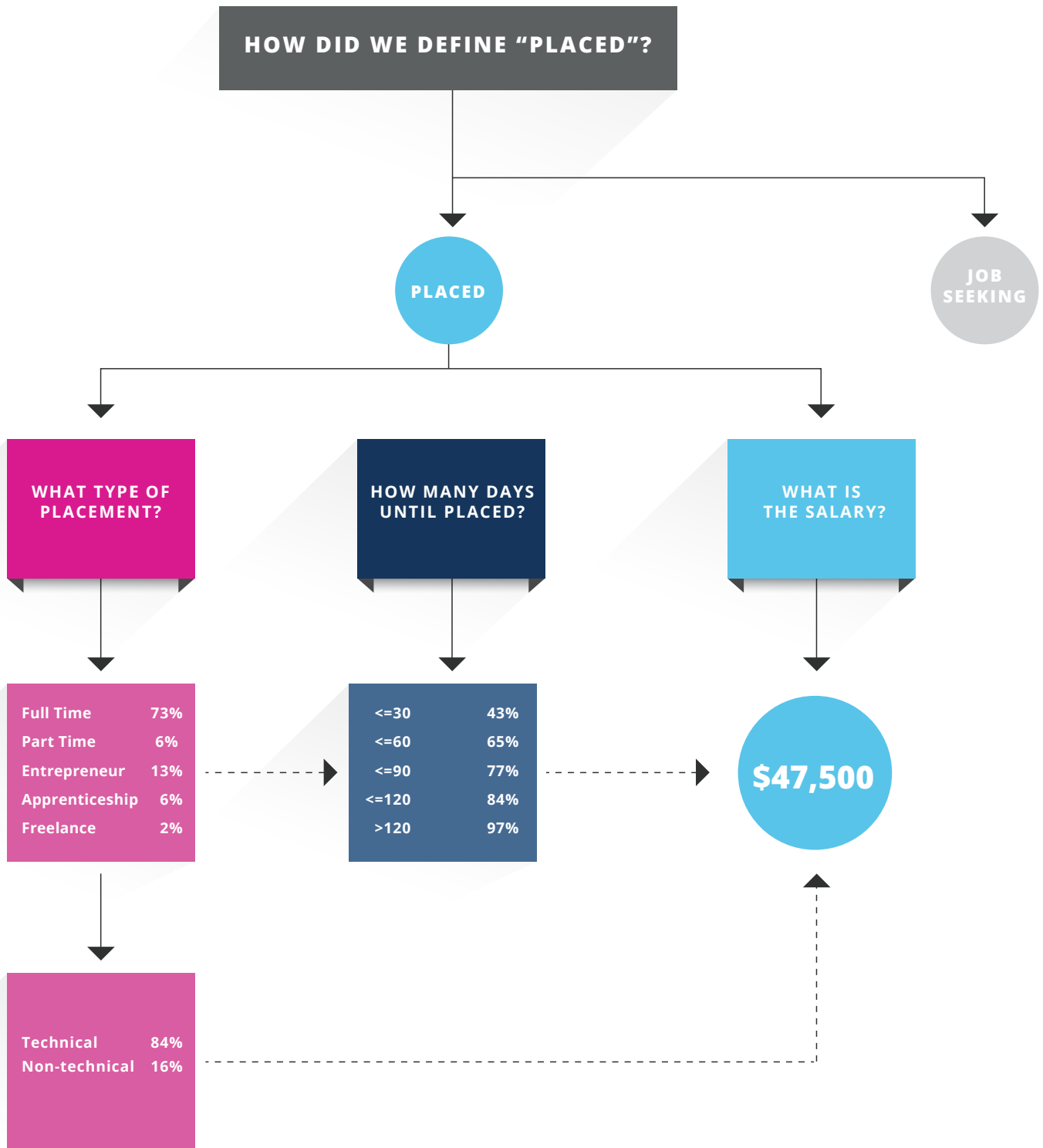
